- Clive Barker, famous horror fiction writer. Directed the film 'Hellraiser' based on his own book 'Hellbound'
- David Yip, actor ('Indiana Jones and the Temple of Doom' & James Bond's 'A View to a Kill')
- **Jimmy Tarbuck**, famous comedian and TV presenter
- Wayne Rooney, arguably one of the most famous footballers in the world today
- Steven Gerrard, probably the most loved footballer to ever grow up in Liverpool.
- Atomic Kitten, English girl group from Liverpool with singers Natasha Hamilton, Liz McClarnon, and Jenny Frost who replaced Kerry Katona
- Ian McCulloch, lead singer of Echo and the Bunnymen
