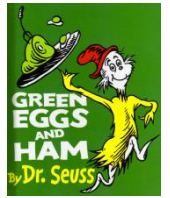








	<b>sun</b> You must wear sunglasses in the sun.	<b>sunny</b> It's a sunny day. It's sunny.	The sun is shining.
	<b>rain</b> 'Singing <b>in</b> the rain'	<b>rainy</b> It's a rainy day.	It's raining.
	<b>cloud</b> Can you see the sun in the clouds ?	<b>cloudy</b> It's a cloudy day. It's cloudy.	/
	<b>snow</b> Let's go and play in the snow !	<b>snowy</b> It's a snowy day.	It's snowing.
	<b>wind</b> I like flying my kite in the wind.	<b>windy</b> It's a windy day.	The wind is blowing.
	<b>storm</b> It is frightening in a storm !	<b>stormy</b> It's a stormy day.	I can <u>hear</u> thunder and <u>see</u> lightning during a storm.
	<b>fog</b> I can't see in the fog.	<b>foggy</b> It's a foggy day.	/
	<b>heat</b> It's unbearable in this heat.	<b>hot</b> It's a hot day.	/
	<b>cold</b> It's unbearable in this cold.	<b>cold</b> It's a cold day.	/
	<b>frost</b> Frost is dangerous on the roads.	<b>frosty</b> It's a frosty day.	When it's frosty, I'm freezing cold !
	<b>rainbow</b> Is there gold hidden under a rainbow ?	/	Sometimes there is a rainbow after a storm.
