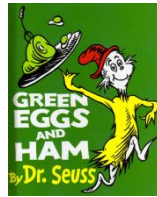

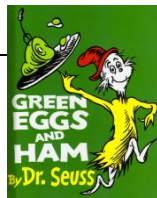

Types of sentences search

Exemples de réponses attendues

Question sentences / *Phrases interrogatives* :

- Do you like green eggs and ham ?
- Would you eat them here or there ?
- Could you eat them on a train ?
- Etc.

Negative sentences / *Phrases négatives* :

- I do not like green eggs and ham.
- I would not eat them anywhere.
- I will not eat them with a mouse.
- Etc.

Affirmative sentences / *Phrases affirmatives* :

- I am Sam.
- I like green eggs and ham !
- I would eat them on a boat.
- I will eat them in the rain.
- They are so good !
- Etc.

Imperative sentences / *Phrases impératives* :

- Let me be !
- Try them !
- Say !
