a piece of literature

- its style
- its narrator
- its genre(s) = express a critical opinion on the literariness of that piece of literature
- the narrative
- its scope



your own reading and motivations

- why you chose that piece of literature
- highlight elements/aspects and/or passages that are important to you
- talk about your own experience as a reader



language and communication

- use a wide range of vocabulary
- intonation is quite natural and communicative
- pronunciation is nearly authentic
- the syntax is elaborate (relative clauses, link words)



quotes, implicit messages

- explain at least one implicit message
- illustrate your views with two quotes



the historical and literary backgrounds

- describe the historical and political context
- refer to another writer of that same period
- explain the specific purpose(s) of that kind of literature in its time



the writer

- briefly introduce her biography
- choose one element in her biography to justify your perception of her story
- quote a passage from her interview to illustrate your development

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
