

**Your task** : You participate in a competition to illustrate Once Upon a Time. This short story will be included in a selection of short fiction entitled “**Writers in Their Own Times : Revisiting Fairy Tales and Nursery Rhymes for Adults**” designed for young adults to entice them to read. Your project of illustration must represent the house. Draw the property as you picture it after reading the whole story. Of course, in order not to reveal the end of the story or influence the readers, the illustration will be published on the page following it.

**Group work** :

1. Have a look at the illustrations in silence,
  - + pay attention to details and their relevance to the story,
  - + do not only focus on the designers’ artistic skills.
  - + Be ready to speak your mind and make a choice.
2. Debate. Justify your opinion by explaining
  - + why it is relevant to represent the house in a way or another,
  - + what significant details are enhanced,
  - + what kind of atmosphere is conveyed.
3. Then decide which project best illustrates the house. You may also decide to combine two projects to make one illustration.

**Criteria to choose a project:**

- the most telling / meaningful / striking details of the description are taken into account
- some features are enhanced
- the picture gives us some insight into the narrator's vision of that society
