Mise en œuvre :

1. Envoyer aux élèves les différents documents.

2. Les élèves devront étudier les tweets, puis écrire leur propre tweet à l'aide du site <https://tweetgen.com/create/tweet.html>. Ils le posteront sur le pad, afin de créer un fil de discussion ou l'enverront sur l'ENT.

En respectant la règle du réseau social, le tweet ne doit pas dépasser 280 caractères.

Les élèves s'entraînent à exprimer un message concis et percutant autour de la problématique de la séquence : peut-on mélanger sport et engagement ?

3. Les élèves visionneront la publicité Nike et prendront des notes, à leur rythme, avant de rédiger un compte-rendu : deux parcours sont proposés (A2 ou B1). L'enseignant peut décider du parcours de l'élève ou leur laisser le choix. Une checklist sera proposée afin de guider les élèves dans la rédaction du compte-rendu.

Productions possibles (question 5) : *When you really believe in something, you need to keep trying, you must not give up. Colin Kaepernick believed in something and he sacrificed his career to defend the cause he believed in.*
